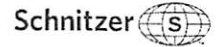

	<p>Appliances (electrical parts removed); Automobiles (all fluids drained and tires/batteries/undeployed air bags removed); Drums/barrels; Gas cylinders/propane tanks (if main valve has been removed); Cable wires; Metals; Aerosol cans (empty). <u>No microwaves, paint cans, or hazardous waste.</u> http://www.schnitzersteel.com/sell_to_us_what_we_buy.aspx</p>
	<p>Computers, TVs, Monitors, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Keyboards/Mice, Phones, Computer wires, cables, and more: http://tncomputerrecycling.com/products-we-recycle/</p>
	<p>Almost all household and clothing items, EXCEPT: baby equipment (strollers, highchairs, carseats), large appliances, beds/bed frames, anything with exposed wires.</p>
	<p>All HI-5 containers (aluminum, glass, plastic). Please ensure they are cleaned and empty, with all caps removed. We do not accept curbside recyclables, as they are typically easily recycled at home. http://www.rrrhi5.com/Recycling_Info.html</p>
	<p>Household cooking oil only. Commercial cooking oil is not accepted at AARDs. Please ensure containers are sealed and not leaking.</p>

	<p>Printer cartridges; Small Electronics (laptops, cell phones, cameras, components & accessories).</p>
