Snow Days and Late Starts

As the weather gets colder with the possibility of snow, we wanted to update you on our snow day/late start policies.

- Mr. Cantu will decide by 5:00 am if school will be delayed or canceled for the day. It will then be posted on the front page of the school website, on our Facebook page and, for those that have signed up for texting, it will be texted to you.
- At 6:00 am, a call will go out to all the number we have in our database, which will result in you getting multiple calls. We know this is annoying, but we need to make sure that everyone gets the message. Even if you received the text, you will still get the call.
- If a late start is decided upon, school will begin 2 hours late.
- If there is a late start, there will be no Pre-K.
- For both late starts and snow days, Morning BASS will be closed. On late starts, afternoon BASS will still be open.
- Please do not rely on the local news or school district closures; always check our website or Facebook page for the correct information.
- Since families live all over, it is an excused absence if you choose to keep children home because of the weather; just please remember to call.
