# PE / Spanish

# **Letters / Phonics**

In Phonics we will:

- Review Phonic Charts 6-9
- Introduce Phonics Charts 10 & 11
- Students will learn that a root word is - a word we start with Introduce the concept of a suffix - a letter or group of letters added to the end of a word to make a new word
- Identifying how many syllables are in a word
- Underling the root word and circling the suffixes.

## **STEAM**

In November, we read *Where* the *Wild Things Are* and used engineering to design solutions to problems Maxx encountered.

December is all about Christmas in the STEAM lab! We will be working on some secret STEAM surprises along with some winter themed challenges.

## Math

Math Students will focus on mastering the following math concepts this December:

- Telling time to the hour and half hour
- Finding greatest and least numbers
- Addition families 8-9
- Subtraction families 8-9
- Combining dimes, pennies, nickels
- · Odd/even numbers
- Before/after/between numbers
- Using a ruler
- Story Problems
- · Math Test every Wednesday
- · Practice math facts daily

The students work extremely hard this time of year and love to showcase all they have learned so far in music and take part in the special celebration of Christ's birth.
