

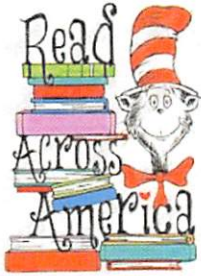

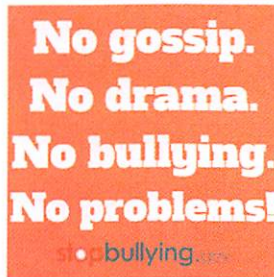
Students may wear appropriate St. Patrick's Day shirts March 1-15.
