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CERTIFICATION OPPORTUNITY

The DOE, in partnership with the New York State Clinically-Rich Intensive Teacher Institute, aims to ensure that English Language Learners (ELLs) have additional qualified and certified teachers in the areas of English as a New Language (ENL) and bilingual education. Through a state grant that partners with local schools of higher education, eligible DOE teachers can earn a tuition discount of \$300/credit towards advanced certificate and extension programs in ENL and bilingual education for those seeking an additional license.
