1.0 Old Business

- Minutes from the October 16, 2018 meeting were unanimously approved.
- Mrs. Brockett presented “Micro Team Meetings”, a 40-60 hour training hosted by CCEA. Teachers would receive CU's and parents and support staff would get the training. The first 40 people to sign up would attend free.
- Mrs. Brockett also encouraged parents, teachers, and support staff to complete the CCSD survey found on the computer

2.0 New Business

- What is the Nevada Plan
Amy Slighting, an advocate for “Hope for Tomorrow” presented the Nevada Plan to those in attendance. The Nevada Plan was created by the Legislature in 1967. The goal of this plan is to make sure that every child in the state of Nevada would have a reasonably equal educational opportunity. It is also the statewide formula-based funding mechanism for public K-12 education.
- National average per student ratio is \$12,000. Nevada's average is \$5,700. Nevada is ranked 48th in 2017 for per pupil allotment.
- NEA (National Education Association) states that Nevada is #47 in 2016 and #48 in 2017 for revenue
- NEA also stated that Nevada is ranked 1st in 2017 for largest class sizes
- Teacher's salary in Nevada is 39th in the nation
