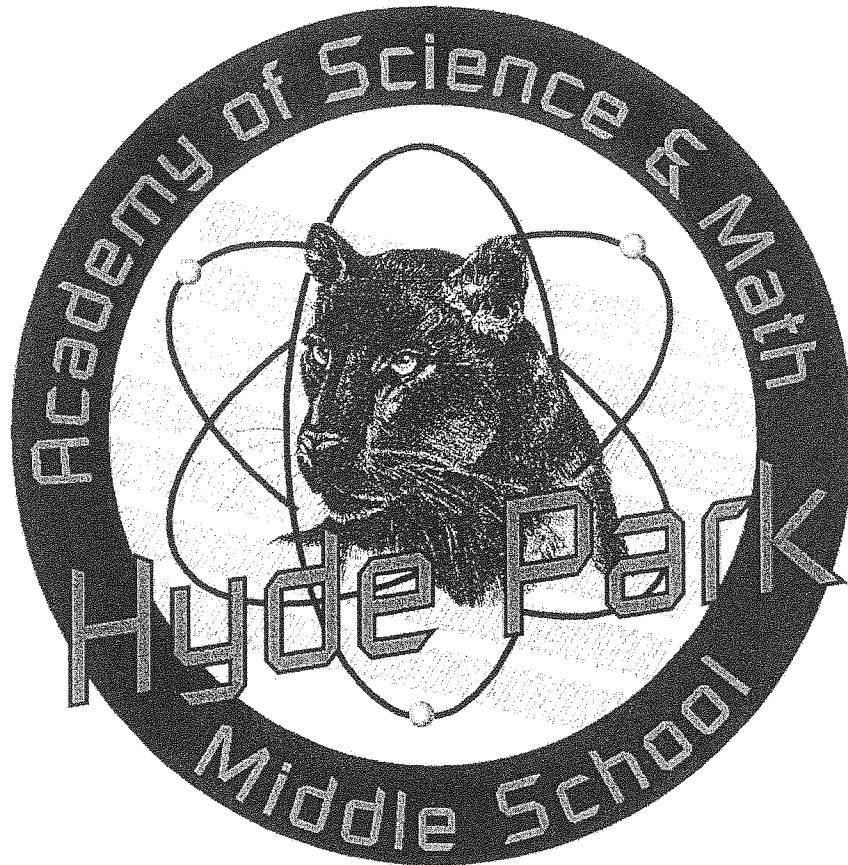

CAMP GOAL

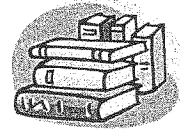

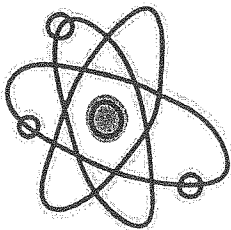
WHO CAN ATTEND THE CAMP?

The cost of the five (5) day camp is \$150.00. This fee covers the following:



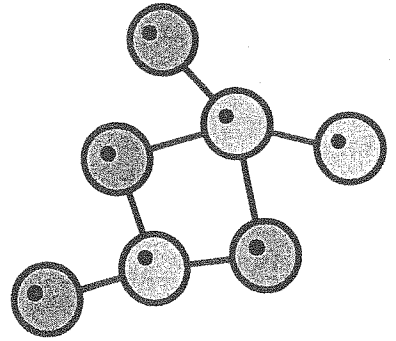
