### A Few Reminders...

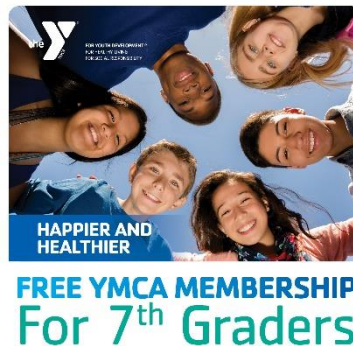
