DIRECTIONS:

- ❖ Students should choose books at their interest and reading level.
- ❖ Students need to complete at least 1 BINGO line (across, up-and-down, or diagonal)
- ❖ Students MUST have a parent/guardian signature in EACH box completed along with the book/author information required.
- ❖ Students may complete more than one BINGO line, but only one line is required
- ❖ Free Space counts as a completed book and doesn't need a signature

GRADING:

- Students will receive points for completed boxes in one BINGO line (MUST have parent/guardian signature)
- Students will have an in-class writing assignment related to their BINGO chart
- Extra credit for multiple B-I-N-G-Os OR BLACK OUT!
- Completed B-I-N-G-O charts are due to homeroom teachers on the first day of the 2019 – 2020 school year!
