Students are back to their sports games/practices: remember to update your authorization form. BASS needs to know who is/are the authorized person(s) to sign out your child/ren.

Parents/guardians it is also very important that you will fill out the Dismissal Procedure Form if you're giving your student permission to walk by themselves to and from the gym or going home from BASS.

I know everyone is feeling uneasy about the Covid-19 virus. I want to assure you that at BASS, we've been working with the students to promote good hygiene practices. We've been reminding students to wash their hands especially after playing games or toys, not touching their face, and no

hugging or handshaking until further notice. We are working hard to ensure that the students are washing their hands after recess and before snack times. We suspended the hi -five gesture and encouraging the use of the peace sign instead.

The telephone is being sanitized daily as well as the pens that you use for your signatures. Legos and Jenga have also been sanitized.

I will be thinking and praying for all of you, please do the same for my family, especially for my Mom. In behalf of the BASS program we wish you a Safe and Blessed Easter.
