April 23, 2019

Kelly Kirkland, Jessica Williams, Tammy Poindexter, Barbara Foster, Susan Matthews, Aaron Tuck, Ashley Dezern, Renee Haraway, Jill Crews, and Amy DeBord were in attendance.

Committee members gave updates on NCStar Indicators.

1. 28 people responded to the Communications survey sent out by Renee Haraway. The survey documented that staff is communicating with parents via newsletter and website, Dojo and Remind apps, phone calls and conferences.
2. Observations by Mr. Sorrell and Mrs. Kirkland continue to occur. They continue to collect data for GRR and have noted that over time there has been an increase in student collaboration.
3. Data continues to be discussed in PLTs. K-2 discussed progress monitoring, mClass and DIBLES and 3-6 discussed Check-In data. Scarlet began looking at iReady EOY diagnostic data with those that were finished. Kindergarten examined KEA data.
4. Jessica Stump and Mr. Duggins met with PLTs to share an overview of MTSS. Mary Anne and Mrs. Kirkland will meet with Nancy Keefer (our regional MTSS director) on April 24, 2019. Mrs. Kirkland is working on finalizing the MTSS team.
5. PBIS continues to have data meetings and quarterly rewards. Bus of the Month also continues. The new criteria for PBIS will involve MTSS. A suggestion was made to have Bus Riders of the month instead or in addition to Bus of the Month.

In lieu of a fall book fair to raise funds for the media center, Tammy is working with an author/illustrator who will create a book specific to and about Yadkinville Elementary. Each illustration uses all the letters of the alphabet. She has an example in the media center. Please share with her images that embody Yadkinville Elementary. The bell and playground were suggested. Books will be \$15. The school will receive \$5 from each book sale.
