PARENTS & STUDENTS

Teaching and learning are secondary to our students' physical and emotional well-being right now. As we implement processes to protect the safety of our students, staff, and families, we are also developing an At-Home Learning Plan that adheres to the CDC's protocols of social distancing. We will be using this platform until we return to school on Monday, April 6th.

Beginning Monday, March 23rd, teachers will be posting all lessons on Google classroom. Students will need to check their student email and Google classroom daily to make sure they are receiving all required information in a timely manner. Students will need to email their teacher regarding any questions they may have with their lessons.

If your student does not have a Chromebook, we will be distributing loaner Chromebooks on Sunday, March 22nd from 1 - 3 pm. During this window parents and students will be required to remain in their vehicle and simply pull through the front driveway of the junior high. School staff will assist you while you remain in your vehicle.

If you do not have access to internet, a few hotspots will be available for checkout during this time as well. This will be on a first come first serve basis. Suddenlink is also providing free internet during this time. Please call Suddenlink at 1-888-633-0030 to sign up for this service.

In the event that your student will not have a Chromebook, a paper packet will be provided to your student. You will be able to pick this packet up Sunday, March 22nd from 1 - 3 pm as well. If your student has left their Chromebook at school, they will also be able to pick it up Sunday from 1 - 3 pm. Again, parents and students will be asked to remain in their vehicle and school personnel will assist you.

The school nurse will also be available during this time to distribute any medication your child has at school.
