 - Lined white 3x5 index cards

*As a gift, you will be given an assignment pad that you will be using daily.

*You will be using a locker next year. Unfortunately, **backpacks with wheels do not fit in the lockers**. Please keep that in mind when selecting a backpack.

*No handheld pencil sharpeners, please.
