

District Advisory Team

Date: February 13, 2018

Location: 411 N. Gibson St.

- I. Shelle Blaylock welcomed everyone and thanked them for their attendance at this rescheduled meeting.
- II. Mrs. Blaylock introduced Trent Smith with Templeton Demographics. Mr. Smith briefed the team on demographers' methodology as to community/school district growth and how they approach rezoning issues. They look at such things as housing starts, natural boundaries (highways, bodies of water, etc...) new housing developments and new communities.

The team was given packets with Junior High and Elementary rezoning plans and reports. This included growth forecast to the school year 27/28. Mr. Smith stressed that while five year forecasts are fairly accurate, the ten-year forecast is less so, due to things such as economic downturn or surges.

The packets included different elementary "feeder patterns" to the three junior highs.

Large color-coded maps were made available for the group to view and ask questions.
- III. It was announced that due to the large amount of information provided and the need to have time to study the rezoning plans, a District Advisory Team meeting would be called after the District Rezoning Forum on February 20, for DAT members to come together again with additional questions and to try to finalize a plan.
- IV. Mrs. Blaylock asked the team to review the minutes from the November 16, 2017 meeting. A typo was caught and the word "mad" in section III, first bullet point was to be corrected to "made". Paul Kuhn, made a motion to accept the minutes with the correction. Shyla Vire seconded and the motion carried.
