For Your Information: In keeping with the 27 year record of Orphan Grain Train, virtually every cent goes to the actual humanitarian work. Orphan Grain Train, Inc. spends only 1.7% of its revenue for administration or marketing. 98.3% is directed entirely toward the mission of Christian humanitarian relief. The largest costs ultimately are for shipping. A 40 foot shipping container will cost anywhere from \$4,000 to \$17,000 depending on where it may be going in the world--just shipping cost.

Drop-off and Pick-up- Our number one priority during these times is the **safety** of our students and families. Please continue to follow the procedures for dropping off and picking up your children. As another precaution and safety measure, please do not make U-turns in front of the school during morning drop-off.
