Two female NVMS students reported to their teacher that on Thursday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, after school, they were approached by a man matching the description given on the local news the previous night, who was involved in an attempted kidnapping. They stated that he was wearing the same bright green shirt and the van matched the description as well. The incident occurred in front of the Niu Valley Shopping Center 7-Eleven store.

The description of the man who attempted to kidnap a teenager in Kapolei the night before is: 5'6", 140 – 160lbs, short hair, dark complexion, wearing a fluorescent green shirt and jeans. Suspect was driving a silver pickup truck.
