## Teacher's Corner

We are working on volleyball skills in physical education. These include passing, setting, hitting, serving and blocking. Passing arguably is the most important skill because it transitions from defense to offense in one action. It takes courage to pass a hard hit, spike or serve. In class the students are not being hit at or served to so they can learn the proper way to do it before they have to dig it. Serving is second most important because it's the only time when a player has full control of the ball. Plus if you are really good at it you score points. Setting is next in the progression, it allows for an offense to be run allowing teams to attack the ball. Attack is the final action in offense and the most dynamic and memorable. It can really pump the crowd. Blocking is an important defense skill. Then back to the pass or dig. The students are doing very well and progressing. We will work on one skill a day for two weeks.
