**Wear sports apparel!**



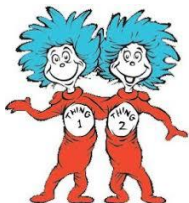
**Tuesday, Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>** – Put drugs to sleep!
