**Raegan Holek**

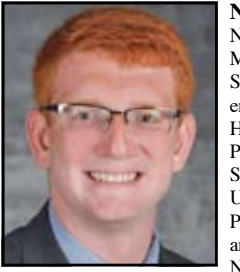
