# *Immunizations Required by Delaware Law*

---

Prepare early and have your child's immunization and physical up to date. Children entering kindergarten must be 5 before August 31. The following will be collected at kindergarten registration when advertised for your school or district.

## Immunizations

- 5 or more doses of DTaP, DTP or TD vaccine (unless 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 4 doses of IPV or OPV (unless 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 2 doses of MMR measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (first dose after the age of 12 months, second dose after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday)
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- 2 doses of Varicella or a written disease history by a licensed healthcare provider

## Physical Exam

- Current doctor exam (within the two years prior to entry into school)
- If entering kindergarten should be your child's 5 year visit with immunizations

## Tuberculosis

- Mantoux screening completed within the past 12 months or risk assessment as recommend by Delaware division of Public Health

## Lead Blood Level

- Documentation for children entering kindergarten or preschool program
