

MJMS Dress Code: What Not to Wear

<p><u>No sagging / baggy pants.</u></p>  <p><u>No torn or ripped jeans or clothing.</u></p>  <p>Plain white undershirts, hoodies, or any indecent/inappropriate patches, writings, or drawings on clothing are prohibited.</p>  <p>No face or tongue piercing on any student. Traditional ear piercings are allowed on girls.</p>  <p>Beards are not allowed. Mustaches must be well groomed. No facial hair below the lips is permitted. Sideburns must not extend below the lower edge of the ear lobe.</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May wear one stud earring in each ear • Ear spacers/plugs/gauges/spikes are not allowed. • No earbuds, headphones are allowed <p>Any apparel that distracts from the learning atmosphere will be considered inappropriate. Cleanliness, neatness, and good taste are the standards by which school personnel judge appropriate dress. Any apparel or unusual accessory that distracts from school decorum is not acceptable as appropriate dress for school.</p>	<p>Non-instructional Items</p> <p>CD players, laser pointers, radios, MP3 players, video or audio recorders, DVD players, personal laptops, cameras, games and other similar items are prohibited at school.</p>  <p>Cell phones shall not be turned on or used during the school day. Cell phones must remain out of sight throughout the school day. No cell phones will be permitted on campus during State Mandated TAKS testing dates.</p> <p>Liquid paper, paint pens, permanent markers are not allowed.</p> <p>Unconventional colored, multicolored, spiked mohawk, or faux hawk hairstyles are <u>not</u> permitted.</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • no shaved or cut designs are allowed. <p><u>No</u> chains or spiked bracelets, rings or chokers. Jewelry/accessories considered dangerous are prohibited.</p>  <p>PANTS/SHORTS: blue jean, khaki, black SHIRTS: 6th-Gray, 7th-Purple, 8th-Black or Yellow</p>	<p>No hats, caps, skullcaps, bandanas and other headgear. Sunglasses are not permitted during the instructional day.</p>  <p>Skirt length must be no shorter than 3" above the knee, even with leggings.</p>  <p><u>No</u> sleepwear or slippers.</p>  <p>Failure to comply with dress code will result in the immediate placement of the student in ISS until the violation is corrected.</p>
