Courses Available

Each concentrator level course is a pre-requisite for Art of Animation II or Art of Graphic Design II

Art of Animation (UC“f”): Learn the history and art of animation and the mechanics of movement while developing classical hand-sketching techniques and 2D and 3D animation software skills.

Art of Graphic Design I (UC“f”): Learn the art and appreciation of graphic design, explore basic elements of composition, and apply principles of design to typography, photography, and illustration.

Students who complete Art of Animation OR Art of Graphic Design I and a capstone earn CTE Design, Visual, & Media Arts Pathway Completion certificates.

Art of Animation II (UC“f”): Refine 2D and 3D illustration and image editing techniques to express ideas visually and communicate animated narratives with creativity and individual artistic style.

Art of Graphic Design II (UC“f”): Refine and enhance skills and techniques in digital composition, photo editing, and illustration while developing and applying an understanding of graphic design for both artistic and commercial visual expression. Explore a variety of interests in graphic design specialties, career opportunities, historical and cultural perspectives, and commercial applications. By the end of the course, students will have a curated portfolio of their own completed graphic art work projects.
