What is LEEP?

CSP's Learn and Earn Employment Program (**LEEP**) is an employment skills training program. **LEEP** will deliver eight weeks of classroom training and entry-level work experience for out-of-school youth, between the ages of 16 and 24 years. Our goal is that all youth who successfully complete the program will enter full-time employment, the military or postsecondary/advanced training that leads to an industry recognized credential.
