Dear Brookwood HS Parents and Community Members,

As we wind down the SY18-19 school year, the Gwinnett County School Nutrition Program would like to thank you for your support and the opportunity to provide meals to your students throughout the school year. We have over 1,500 school nutrition professionals who strive to provide healthy and nutritious breakfast and lunch meals to all the students of Gwinnett County Public Schools.

Brookwood HS has had the opportunity to offer Universal Breakfast, which meant that all students were able to receive breakfast at no charge. However, this will change in SY19-20.

Effective August 5, 2019, the Gwinnett County School Nutrition Program has made the decision that Universal Breakfast will only be available to designated GCPS Title 1 Middle Schools and High Schools. For SY19-20, Brookwood HS will not be a designated GCPS Title 1 school and therefore will not be eligible to offer Universal Breakfast.

However, breakfast service will still be available daily and all students will still have access to breakfast service. All students will be required pay for their breakfast based on their current eligibility status. The breakfast prices for SY19-20 are:

<b>Free</b>	<b>No Charge</b>
<b>Reduced</b>	<b>\$.30 cents</b>
<b>Full Pay</b>	<b>\$1.50</b>

You will still be able to add funds to your child's account just as you have always done by visiting <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com/welcome>. Please keep in mind that it can take up to 24 hours for funds to show up at the school level.
