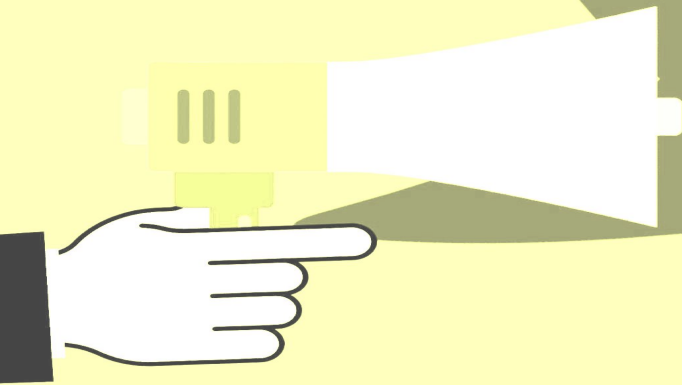
**Knowledge** - Learn about what makes our community, our schools, district programs, students, teachers, district staff, families, and the future so amazing!
