Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you of the schedule for the upcoming New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA), which is replacing the PARCC assessment, that will be administered to students in grades 3-high school. Like last year, students will only participate in one (1) testing window. For ELA and Math, the testing schedule will be:

Lafayette Elementary School (Grade 3 Only) May 7- May 16, 2019 Smalley Elementary School May 7- May 16, 2019 Community Middle School April 9- April 11, 2019 & April 30- May 2, 2019 Bound Brook High School April 9- April 11, 2019 & April 30- May 2, 2019

Students in Grades 5, 8 & 11 will also take the NJSLA-Science test which will take place May 29 -May 30, 2019.

In order to minimize the impact on the classroom instruction and the typical school day, we will only administer one section per day. Our goal is to begin the NJSLA assessment in the morning following breakfast. All testing will take place during the morning and the schools will operate on an adjusted scheduled. It is important that your child arrives to school on time. All children in a testing group will begin testing at the same time. Testing times are not flexible and children who arrive late will not be allowed to test in that session Make up testing for all three subjects will be as needed in each building. If there is a delayed opening, or if school is closed due to inclement weather, testing will be rescheduled.

We will explain testing expectations to the children to reduce anxiety. Please do help us to have testing run as smoothly as possible and assist us in making sure that your child is ready and prepared to do their best on the testing days. We ask that you ensure that your child is rested, eats breakfast, and is relaxed. Eating breakfast helps keep the children from becoming hungry and distracted. If your child wears a device such as glasses, hearing aids, etc., be sure he/she remembers to bring it and wear it during all testing sessions. Also, students are encouraged to bring their own earbuds/headphones for testing. Encourage your child to do his/her best work possible, but try not to be overly anxious about test scores. Too much emphasis on test scores can be upsetting to children.
