

Sports Participation Information

Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School offers to its students the chance to participate in an interscholastic athletic program. We maintain the parents/guardians and students both need to cooperate and confirm to directions, instructions, and rules established by MCP, the Athletic Director, coaches, and referees responsible for any of the sports in which your student(s) may be participating.

All students who wish to participate in any MCP sport must complete an annual physical to establish that they are physically fit and capable of participating in interscholastic athletics.

All parents/guardians and students are asked to recognize that a representative of Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School exists in the capacity to tend to students. All parents/guardians and students are asked to authorize MCP's representative to consent to and permit any and all necessary medical services that need to be rendered under the general or special supervision and upon the advice of a physician and surgeon licensed under the provisions of the California Medical Practice Act. Parents/Guardians and students are asked to authorize MCP's representative to consent to and permit any x-ray examination, anesthetic, dental or surgical diagnosis, or treatment and hospital care rendered by a dentist licensed under the provisions of the Dental Practice Act. All parents/guardians and students are asked to authorize MCP's representative to use his/her judgment in obtaining medical services, and they are also asked to understand that neither the school nor the Diocese of Monterey assumes responsibility for payment of any medical expenses.

All parents/guardians and students are asked to recognize and understand that there is a risk of being injured that is inherent in all sports, that the risk of injury may be severe, including but not limited to the risk of fracture, brain injuries, paralysis, or even death. All parents/guardians and students are asked to waive all claims for damages which either parents/guardians or the student may have, or which may hereafter accrue to parents/guardians or the student against Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School/Diocese of Monterey, for death, personal injuries, and losses or injuries to property, real or personal, cause by or arising out of interscholastic athletics. It is further understood and agreed this waiver and release is to be binding on my successors, heirs, and assigns.

All parents/guardians and students are asked to agree, understand, and consent to transportation being used by Mission College Preparatory Catholic High School.
