**SUBJECT:** City of Bell Safe Routes to School Plan

Dear Mr. Rafael Balderas:

The City of Bell received grant funds to prepare a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Plan. The goal of the SRTS Plan was to increase the number of students walking and biking to school. This SRTS Plan resulted in the following attached documents for your school:

- School Pedestrian Route Map – This Map identifies the recommended route for school pedestrians traveling to/from school. The Map identifies the location of the school, the suggested route (arrows), school boundaries, traffic signal locations, all-way stop locations, etc. This Map should be provided to school parents and students for their information and use. We also recommend this map be posted on the School's website and be available in your school's Parent Resource Center, if applicable.
- School Action Plan – The SRTS Plan developed specific School Action Plans. These Action Plans were a result of several community meetings and include some specific concerns expressed by community members regarding your school. The Action Plans provide each school with tools to encourage increased walking and biking. The City encourages the schools to use these tools based on their needs and support from your parents, students and staff.

The Potential Future Infrastructure Improvements as well as requests for additional traffic control devices will require additional engineering study and design by the City of Bell prior to implementation.

We encourage you to use all these tools to increase walking and biking to your school. The City of Bell will also continue to look for funding for potential future infrastructure improvements. 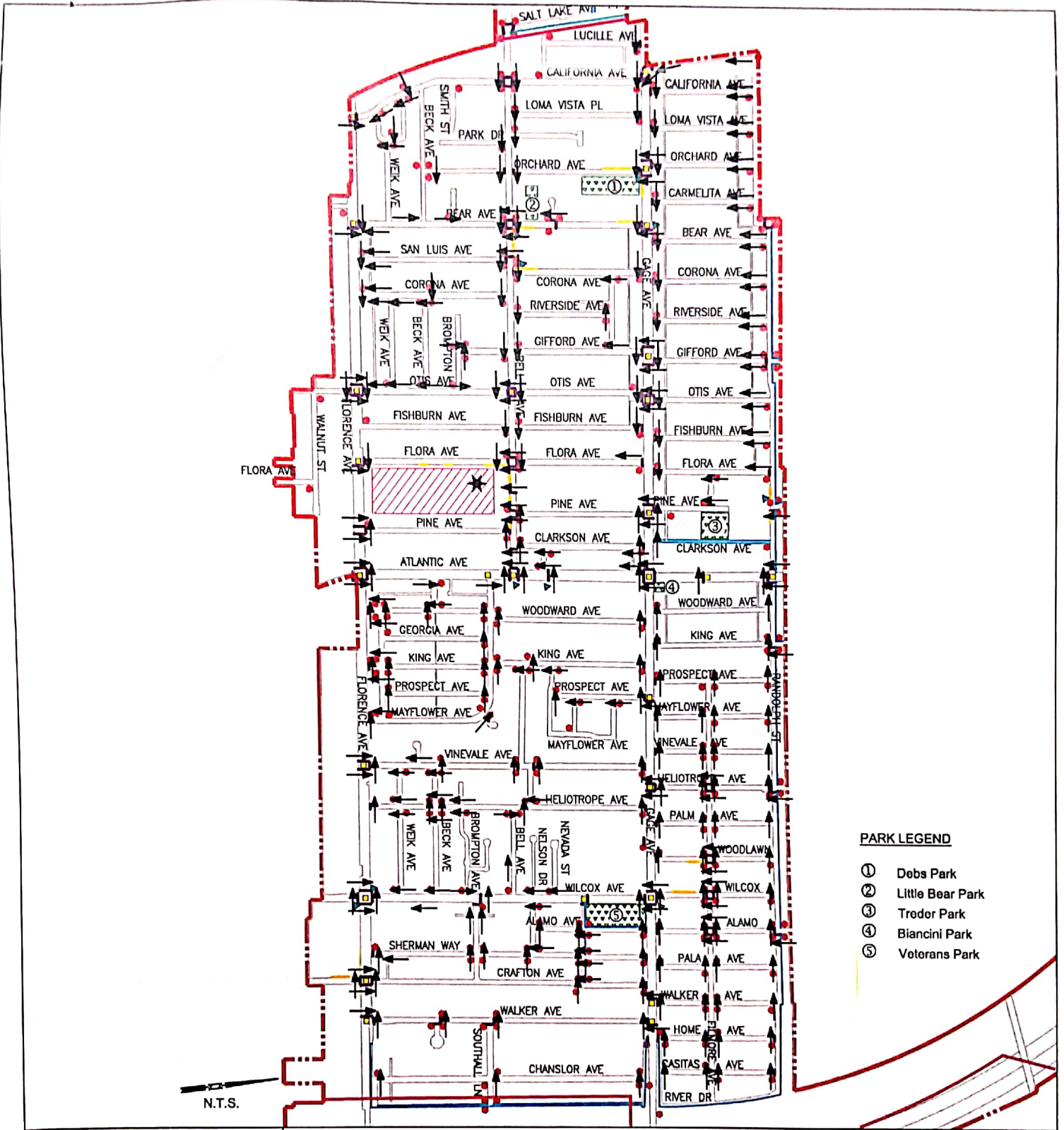
