Golden Oak Montessori is a first through eighth grade public charter school located in Castro Valley, California – in the heart of the San Francisco East Bay.

Our diverse student population is reflective of the Bay Area--more than 17 languages spoken. As a public charter school, we do not charge tuition. Approximately 20% of our 250 students qualify as low-income.

Each class of 25 students has a lead teacher and a full-time classroom assistant. Curriculum is Montessori with Common Core-based tracking. Competitive salary scale.
