D. White Catholic. I will introduce new faculty members in the August Parent Newsletter at the start of the new school year.

The athletic department has the 2019-2020 LHSAA physical forms and code of conduct forms available for pick-up in the main office. All athletes participating in summer conditioning or competitive programs should return the signed forms immediately. Please read and discuss the code of conduct policy with your child so that he/she understands the expectations of the athletic department. Parental support of these policies is essential to their effectiveness and to helping athletes reach their physical and emotional potential.

The main office will remain open during the summer from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM on Monday through Thursday, and all offices will close from June 24 – July 12. Students obtaining driver’s permits and licenses are reminded about the needed form verifying their enrollment status at school; these forms may be picked up from the main office during summer hours. Work permits may be obtained from Mrs. Tricia Gros in the main office until May 31. After this date, students will need to obtain a permit from the secretary at Thibodaux High School.

On June 1, we celebrate the Ordination of two new priests to the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux: Father Patrick Riviere and Father Brett Lapeyrouse. Patrick, son of Robert and Mary Riviere, is a 2010 graduate of E. D. White Catholic. TOPS Eligibility

Members of the Class of 2019 should expect to receive an email from the TOPS office concerning their eligibility by mid-summer. Formal letters are no longer mailed. If you believe you are eligible for TOPS and have not received an email by the middle of July, please contact the LOSFA office at (800) 259-5626, Ext. 1012. Students are cautioned to read their eligibility letter carefully. The TOPS Tech Award can only be used for skill or occupational training. The TOPS Opportunity, Performance, and Honors Awards can be used for an academic undergraduate degree, vocational or technical certificate, or a non-academic degree.

Planning for College

There is no better way to learn about a college or university than to visit the campus when classes are in session. It is better to see with your own eyes, rather than rely upon the views of others. Students are encouraged to make campus visits during our summer break. Campus visits (tours, advanced placement testing, scholarship interviews, orientations, and/or auditions) taken on a school day are considered educational absences; however, these absences are limited to three days total over the junior and senior years.



EDW RINGS

This notice is for parents who will be purchasing graduation rings in the future. The only rings distributed for graduation and allowed to be worn at school are the official rings. Our current supplier is Jostens. A Jostens representative will be on campus from time to time to speak with parents. Any student wishing to wear a former graduate's ring must have the ring approved by the school administration. This policy is in effect to ensure that our senior rings reflect the philosophy and tradition of E. D. White Catholic High School.

MOTHERS CLUB

The Mothers Club of EDW would like to welcome all families that will be joining EDW in the fall. Our organization was founded in the 1930s by a group of mothers seeking to raise funds for EDW. These funds have been used over the years to provide financial support to the school with the intention of enhancing and supplementing the educational, physical and spiritual needs of the students and faculty. Mothers Club is also proud to support student life events, student clubs and classroom teacher grants.

Our main source of income is the Gym Dandy thrift store, which was started in the 1970s when the members recognized the Thibodaux community's need for clothing and household items. Since our first rummage sale in the EDW Gym, our club has raised and donated over \$1,100,000 to the school. Some of the items donated include academic jackets, chapel remodel, computer technology and software, classroom desks, and two school buses. We also donated a portion of funds needed for the EDW prayer garden.

Gym Dandy will be open during the summer every Tuesday and the first Saturday of each month from 9:00 A.M. until 12:00 P.M. We are open to accept donations and work with inventory on Thursdays. Volunteers are needed, and we hope you will consider joining us. Any amount of time you can give will be greatly appreciated.

Adult volunteers must be safe environment trained as required by our diocese. Students can get their community service hours early by working at Gym Dandy during the summer. Board members and volunteers arrive at 8:15 AM. If you are interested, please contact either Angelle Gros at angellegros@bellsouth.net or Stephanie Robichaux at stephaniedrobichaux@gmail.com. Only six students are permitted to work per day and we ask that they come dressed appropriately to work. PE shorts and any EDW tee are perfect! Students should bring a copy of the EDW Service Hours form. When arriving at the store, students should sign their names in the logbook so that we can give them credit for service hours.

The Mothers Club also supports "Mary's Mothers" which is a group of EDW moms, family members, and community volunteers who participate in Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the EDW Chapel weekly during the school year. We will begin again in September and volunteers will be needed every Wednesday from 7:30 am until 3:00 pm for half-hour or hourly increments of time for prayer. We hope you will consider becoming an active volunteer of our organization this fall. All moms are invited to join. We have lots of activities where you can help and we always try to work around a working mother's busy schedule. 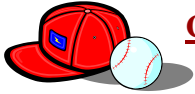
