In the Classroom

Personalized Learning- Differentiated, data-driven instruction focused on improving the reading and math skills of all students.

Project Based Learning opportunities in all content areas-PBL'S will be designed to engage students and actively involve them in exploring real-world problems and challenges as a means of acquiring a deeper knowledge of the academic content.

Parent Communication- Parents will be provided access to the Parent Portal which will allow them to monitor their child's academic progress and attendance. Progress reports will be sent home with their child at the end of the first 4 ½ weeks of each 9 week grading period and report cards at the end of each 9-week grading period.

At Home

- *Monitor my child's academic performance in all content areas by consistently reviewing his/her grades through the Parent Portal and progress reports/report cards sent home every 4 ½ weeks.*
- *Monitor my child's attendance by consistently reviewing his/her attendance through the Parent Portal and progress reports/report cards sent home every 4 ½ weeks..*
- *Encourage my child to read at least 30 minutes a day outside of school.*
- *Stay informed about my child's education, including his/her performance on state mandated tests and participate, as appropriate, in decisions related to my child's education.*

Students

Woodland Middle School students will do the following:

- **Focus on improving my academic achievement in all content areas.**
- **Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school.**
- **Attend school every day and participate productively in all my classes.**
- **Do my homework and classwork every day and ask for help when I need it.**
- **Give to my parents or guardians all notices and information received from the school.**
