Parent Guide

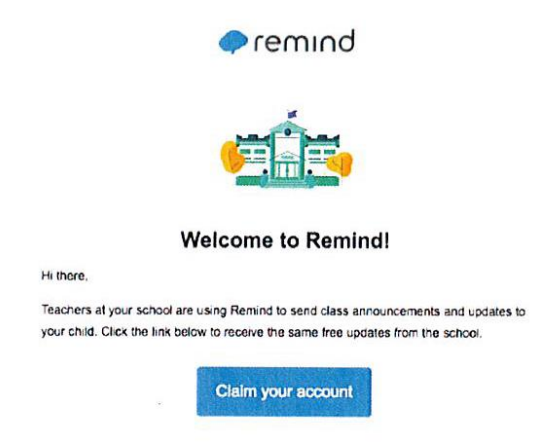
We are excited to share that Hempfield is rolling out Remind districtwide! If you are not familiar with Remind, it is a communication tool that makes it easy to stay involved with your child's learning. Remind is free to use and you will be able to get and send messages on any device-even a simple text message from your phone! The Remind app is also available for free, just search for Remind in your app store.

As a part of this rollout, an official account was created for you. On **August 19th**, you will receive a message from Remind. If you don't see the message, please check your spam folder or make sure your information in Skyward is updated (sample email below). **To receive Remind messages, you will need to use a cell phone number as your main phone number in Skyward.** All you need to do is follow the steps in the message to finish setting up your account. If you already have an existing account, Remind will sync automatically to your account as long as the cell phone and the email address are the same. Do keep in mind all contact information remains private, both the sender number remains the same for each SMS thread, so you can save this as the teacher or school in your phone for easy reference. 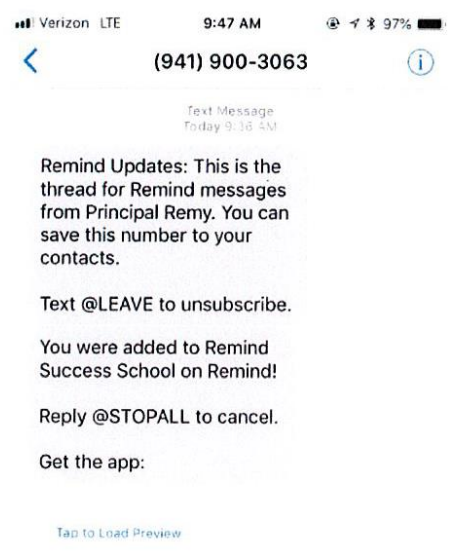
Remind communications may include:
