Superintendent's Report

There is over \$2,000,000 in our fund balance.

The state has recognized a decrease of approximately 40 students in Hampton One. They have withheld part of the base student cost appropriation due to some inaccurate earlier assumptions. They have also decreased from 85% to 84% the amount of the State contribution to the EFA. These three items will cost our district approximately \$300,000.

The shrubbery at North District may be placed as early as next week.
