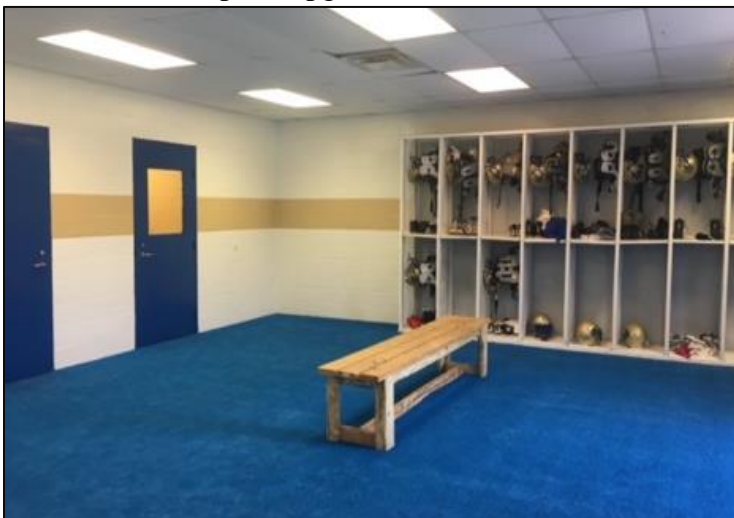
Giving Back to the Community
