Guiding Questions for all books:

- How do different characters communicate to one another?
- How do characters get isolated?
- Why do people act the way they do?

****Be prepared to be assessed on the books upon return to school****

Project Outline – Journal – ***Room*** by Emma Donoghue.

Due Date: Upon return to school.

Guidelines: You are to submit a journal – typed with a cover page. Each journal entry must be titled. Also, each entry should be over one (1) page in length and must be formatted in accordance to the following MLA guidelines:

- 12 point font
- Arial or Times New Roman
- One inch margins on all sides
- Double spaced
- Cover page – Full name, book title and author, English 12

Journal Entries – Eight (8) entries

Directions: ***Room*** is told entirely from the perspective of the little boy Jack. As you read ***Room***, you will create journal entries that reflect as if the story was told from a different perspective, from a different character's P.O.V. The character should be the title of the chapter, as well as when this would take place in the novel. Make sure to follow MLA requirements.

- Each response must demonstrate:
 - Relationship of the character to Jack (and others).
 - Explanation of how the person feels regarding Jack's actions.
 - A well-rounded reading of the text – entries must come from the beginning, middle, and conclusion of the text.
 - Can be any character that interacts with Jack.
 - Cannot use the same character more than twice.
