- LISA Academy offers many other programs to enhance parent and family engagement. One example would be the VOLY website, which allows parents to sign up and choose from existing opportunities to volunteer in the schools.
- Our staff has various methods to translate parent communications into a language the parents can understand; among these methods are Gmail translate, TransACT, phone translation, and staff members who can act as interpreters.

- The ADE's Family and Community website link will be posted on the school website.
- Parent-Teacher conferences days are scheduled two times per year (September 20, 2019, and February 14, 2020). Also, teachers have office hours every week in which parents may schedule meetings.

 - Alumni website is used to communicate and recruit alumni for available part-time and full-time job positions. We also have annual alumni reunions held in the school.
 - LISA Academy West High School will work to restructure the PTO. Ms. Lloyd and Dr. Bakisli will work together to establish a separate High School PTO.
