BUT FIRST, FAFSA – FAFSA FRIDAYS

Get ready to complete your 2019-2020 FAFSA form.

- The FAFSA will be available on Oct. 1, 2018.
- The FAFSA will collect income information from the 2017 tax year.

Lucky for you, the Financial Aid Office at Warren County Community College is available to help you fill out the FAFSA. This service is available to anyone, not just current students.

FAFSA Fridays will continue every Friday while school is in session until April. We don't want you to miss any deadlines so schedule your appointment soon.

Before coming to FAFSA Fridays, students and parents will need to complete an FSA ID to sign the FAFSA electronically.

1. Go to fsaid.ed.gov
2. Create your FSA ID (username and password).

Here's what to bring to FAFSA Fridays.

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your 2017 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned.
 - Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically.

If you are a dependent student, then your parent will also need to come.
