Fountain Valley School District is aware of two programs offering free internet services for qualifying families during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) school closures.



Spectrum Internet Access

Spectrum is offering two free months of internet and WiFi services to new customers in households with Pre-K to 12th grade students who need remote education.

Information is available for families by phone at 1-855-243-8892.

Spectrum's discount will be applied as a credit for your first two months of internet services and Spectrum will waive any installation or pre-payment fees to get you started.

You can qualify for this offer if you:

- Have a student of qualifying age at your service address with remote education needs
- Have not subscribed to Spectrum internet service

Comcast Internet Essentials

Comcast is offering 60-days of free internet services to qualifying new customers to support distance learning for students during school closures.

Information is available via phone at 1-855-8-INTERNET (1-855-846-8376).

If you are eligible for Internet Essentials and are approved for the program, you will automatically receive the 2-month free promotion. After the promotion, regular rates apply unless you disconnect your service.

In order to be considered, you must apply for the Internet Essentials program by April 30, 2020.
