

St. Paul the Apostle Before and Aftercare

Welcome to St. Paul's Before and After School Care. The program provides quality, safe, and affordable childcare before and after school. The children will receive an afternoon snack. The children will have time to complete homework, play outside, and become involved in other after school activities. The Before and After Care program is available to all St. Paul's children from transitional kindergarten thru 6th grade. The program will begin at 7:00 AM to beginning of school, and when school dismisses until 5:30PM, and will be held in Denning Hall (it may be moved to the Early Learning Center 2nd floor in cases of Denning Hall Conflict).

All families are required to register with the Before and After Care program. Students in grades K-6 who are not picked up within 15 minutes of school dismissal will be sent to After Care and charged for the service. For safety reasons, all students must be signed out when they are picked up in Denning Hall.

The Before and After Care program follows the school calendar. There will be Before and After Care on every regular school day. There is **no** After Care on snow days or during holiday breaks. Also, if school is dismissed early due to inclement weather, parents should try to pick up their children as soon as possible due to the anticipation of unsafe travel conditions.

When picking up a child, parents must provide the time and a signature in the check-in/out book. For your child's safety, he/she will not be allowed to leave with anyone except those designated on the registration form. If a child is going home with someone else, permission needs to be provided.

There is a \$25.00 registration fee for this program. The rate for use of the Before/After School Program is \$4.20 per student per hour. There is a 1 hour minimum. Those going over the 1 hour minimum will be billed in 15 minute increments. Late pick up (after 5:30PM) will result in a \$10.00 late fee. All program participants must sign up for automatic payment, which will be processed on either the 5th or the 20th of the month. Please address any questions to Rose Strickland, 322-7994.

The children will be expected to follow St. Paul's school rules while in attendance. If a child gets sick before or after the program starts, he/she may not attend.

The St. Paul's Before and After Care program is licensed by the Department of Human Services and directed by a licensed teacher and staffed by qualified, trained personnel. It was designed to provide a fun and relaxing environment for the children. Good communication with our parents is an essential part of our program. We value each child as an individual and work with our parents to create a warm and welcoming atmosphere where school-age children can feel comfortable and safe.
