

PROM 2019

The fundraisers by the junior class for raising funds for this year's prom banquet, grand march, and dance include:

(1) Trash bags:

If you are not familiar with the trash bags, the company that makes our trash advertises that their trash bags are stronger and cheaper than name brand competitors, such as Hefty Bags. The sizes and number of bags per roll are listed below:

- white trash bags = tall kitchen = 15 gallon = 65 per roll
- yellow trash bags = large garbage can = 39 gallon = 25 per roll
- blue trash bags = extra large/commercial = 55 gallon = 16 bags per roll



Each roll costs \$12. May purchase by the box. There are 10 rolls per box.

Junior students will be talking to their friends, family, and neighbors about ordering or purchasing rolls of trash bags.

- Customers may choose to pay for and pick up their orders at the Cedar office.
- Customers may choose to have the junior deliver their order.
- Or, customers may pick up and pay for their bag orders on Thursday, October 18th between 4:00 and 6:00 P.M. in the entryway of Cedar Catholic High School during a **CASH & CARRY TRASH BAG FUNDRAISER.**

(2) Great American Fundraiser = Magazine, food, gift wrap, cards, etc.:

Juniors will be talking to their friends, family and neighbors about Great American products. The students will have a brochure on paper and electronic magazines. A complete list magazines and catalogue items (wrapping paper, cards, gift bags, foot items, kitchen gadgets, jewelry, etc.) can be viewed on their website.

The Great American Fundraiser runs from September 25^h to October 8th, 2018. **Online orders can still be processed up until December 25th, 2018.**

(3) Schwan's Cares Fundraiser:

Supporters shop online from over 300 high-quality, family pleasing foods that are flash-frozen and delivered to your door. No subscriptions. Order at your convenience. Schedule your delivery. Pay online or when your food is delivered.

Earn up to 40% cash back with every purchase.

- The junior class earns **40%** on each \$25 e-cards (electronic gift cards) that is purchased. We ask that each supporter purchase an e-certificate first, then shop and use it as payment for their first order.
- The junior class earns **20% on order** during the first 45 days of the campaign (**September 26- November 10, 2018**)
- and then the junior class earns **5%** for the next 90 days (**November 11, 2018-February 8, 2019**)

How it works:

- Supporters may live nationwide or where ever Schwan's delivers.
- Supporters may be new or existing Schwan's customers.
- In order for the junior class of Cedar Catholic to receive funds, supporters must purchase items through the Schwan's Cares website.

 - You may type in the junior student's ID number or select their name.
 - Scroll down the screen and select – purchase e-card. Follow the steps on how to purchase a \$25 e-card (an electronic gift card). Then, click on **shop now**.
 - For each additional order throughout this campaign, after locating our campaign, click on **shop now**.
