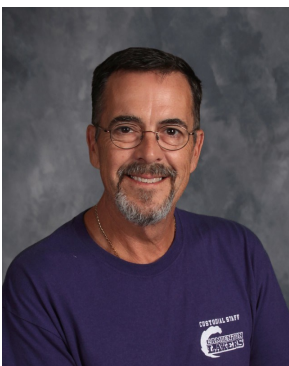


February winners of Classified Employee of the week
