  - 8 Priority Areas- 4 Different Sections
  
- Reviewed dynamics of student population and Academic performance at Birney:
  - English Language Arts
    - All students scored 62 points above standard
    - English learners were 58.6 above standard
    - SES disadvantaged scored 20.4 above standard
  - Mathematics
    - All students 58.6 above standard
    - English Learners 56.2 above standard
    - SES disadvantaged 20.5 above standard
  
- Absences declined across the board in all student populations
  
- School Goal #1- increase number of students who are reading at or above grade-level, students performing at or above grade level in place value standard, increase number of students meeting or exceeding standards in ELA and mathematics on the CAASPP testing
  - We want to increase reading success measured by Fountas and Pinnell by 5%
  - In place value for math we want to increase 2%
  - In ELA and Math 5% increase
    - Teacher differentiate in order for student success
  - 102,000 in Block (base) account- unrestricted
    - LLI, ELL coordinator, instructional materials...etc
  - Birney PTA has their own account
  
- Goal #2- non-academic based opportunities to promote emotional, social, and physical well being
  - Students are provided with morning meeting at least 3 days a week and PE, physical fitness tests
  
- Goal #3- improve practices supporting effective student instruction
  - Teachers will use more of the F&P kits to benefit kiddos
  
- Goal #4- increase parent engagement, involvement, and satisfaction
  - Back to School, Open House, Parent Education Nights
  
- School Safety Plan- Run, hide, fight if there is an intruder
  - Two separate slideshows for K-2 and 3-5

### **Intervention Programs on Campus**

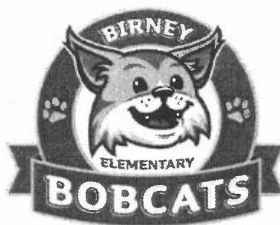
- 1.) Bobcat Club :Monday and Thursday after school
