- **BrainPop** - Designed to actively engage students in grades 3 and up, BrainPOP encompasses more than 650 curricular topics and growing! Science, Social Studies, English, Math, Technology, Arts & Music and Health are all brought to life through short, animated movies and related interactive quizzes and features.
- **BrainPop ESL** - BrainPOP ESL uses lively, engaging content to teach English to speakers of other languages. BrainPOP ESL incorporates listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and is suitable for all non-native speakers - starting at a beginner's level.
- **BrainPop Español** - BrainPOP in Spanish. Ideal for native Spanish speakers, Spanish language students, and bilingual and dual language programs in grades 3 and up.
- **BrainPop Jr.** - Educational resource aligned to standards of Kindergarten through 3rd grade. Covers Science, Reading & Writing, Math, Health, Social Studies, and Arts & Technology.
- **Britannica: ImageQuest** - Provides access to over two million images that can be used by both teachers and students. Includes images from the National Portrait Gallery, the Chicago History Museum, National Geographic Society, and Planet Observer.
- **EBSCO: History Reference Center** - Provides the text of articles on miscellaneous topics in history from a variety of sources, to be used by students while doing research.
- **GALE: Testing & Education Reference Center** - Provides access to research tools on careers and higher education possibilities. Includes tests for certification in a number of vocations along with career planning tools and test-taking strategies.
- **Power Videos** - Presents a collection of over 8,000 videos and on-demand media to be used in schools in Texas.
- **TEXQUEST - Adam Matthew: American Indian Histories & Cultures** - Presents a collection of materials about Native Americans from the collections at the Newberry Library in Chicago.

- **TEXQUEST - Britannica: e-STAX**- Presents a collection of eBooks from Encyclopaedia Britannica.
