Assessment Updates:

- **State Testing, CAASPP**, canceled for this school year.
- **Summative ELPAC** (English Language Proficiency Assessments for California) canceled for this school year.
- **Initial ELPAC** to assess newly enrolled students whose primary language is not English will resume once school is back in session.
- Physical Fitness Test on hold until students return to school.

- **IB (International Baccalaureate) Exams** for Diploma Programme and Career-related Programme canceled.
