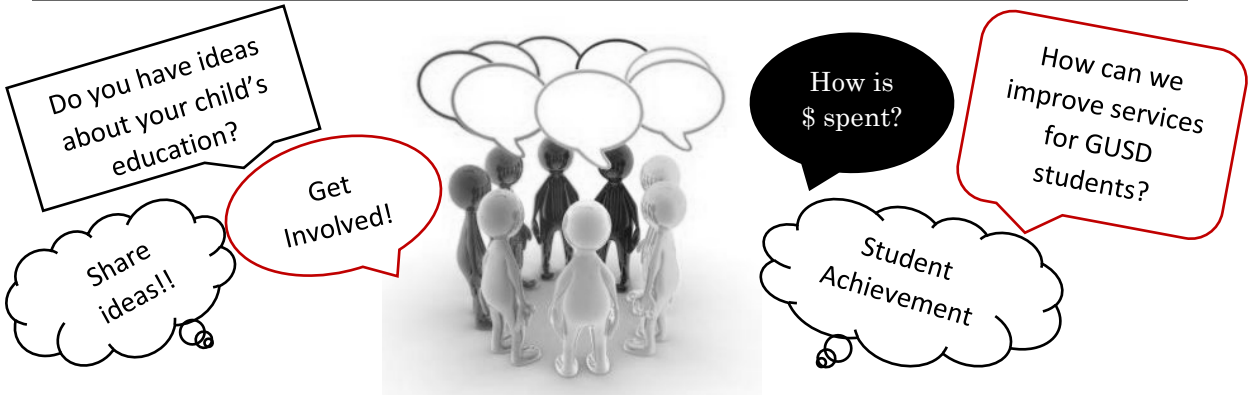




# LCAP Stakeholder Engagement Forums
