Dear CSS Families,

It's beginning to feel like fall and we are gearing up for our annual costume parade at CSS. As you plan ahead, please remember that our school has the following guidelines to keep the atmosphere safe and fun for all:

- Students will be allowed to wear their costumes to school for the parade. Your child's safety is our first concern. We urge you to guide their selection of costumes and costume accessories in a manner that will assure their own vision and their visibility to others.
- To minimize the chance of injury to other students, children may not wear masks that cover their entire face nor may they bring replica weapons. In selecting costumes that are safe, non-offensive, and non-violent, you are taking an active role in your child's safety and well-being. Please refrain from frightening costumes - (no scary clowns)!
- After the parade is finished, students in grades 1st - 5th will be asked to change out of their costumes into regular clothes. Please have a change of clothing prepared for your child, either in their backpacks or underneath their costumes. TK and kindergarten students may remain in their costumes if they choose to do so - but consider the ease of using the bathroom and playing on the playground as you make decisions for our littlest cougars.

Campus Security: We have a tentative date for the installation of the fencing in the front of the school! It is expected that installation will be complete by November 23rd. Stay tuned for updates.

Apple Watches at School: We are having some challenges with distraction caused by students using Apple Watches during class. The rules for these devices are similar to those for cell phones - they may not be used during school hours (8:20-2:45). Consequences for use at school are as follows: First offence: warning. Second offence: teacher holds device for parents to pick up. Third offence: device goes to school administration and the student may not bring device to school for a period of time to be determined by administration. Additionally, CSS is not responsible for the loss or theft of any electronic device brought to school. Thank you for your support in keeping our students focused on learning!

Emergency Notification System: As you all heard at Back to School Night, I have been working on updating the text message system so that all families may be notified as quickly as possible in the event of an emergency or other event that impacts our school. The cell phone numbers that were provided by parents during registration have been put into our school messenger system this week and I will be sending a test message out on Friday. You may receive an "opt in" message. Please reply YES so that you may continue to receive notifications from our school. If you do not receive a text on Friday, please come to the school office next week at your convenience so that we may troubleshoot with you. Our goal is to have the ability to quickly connect with every parent/guardian to share information.
