Randolph Field ISD enrollment remains steady with 1430 current students. A consistent student population benefits the district in several ways, including maintaining an adequate budget. Each year we have waiting lists at all grade levels of students wishing to transfer to our schools. We appreciate the desire for new families to have their children attend RFISD, and we will continue to provide the best education possible in the safest environment possible to all students.

## **RFISD Board Hears Report Update on Long Range Facilities Plan**

The Superintendent gave an update to the Board of Trustees regarding the new construction at the secondary campus. The new transportation and maintenance building is now fully open and operational. The old transportation and maintenance building will be repurposed into a student services building and JROTC facility. Student services that will be housed in it will be GT, Grant Coordinators, COOP professionals, and Special Education services. The new middle school wing, funded by a \$2.9 million grant, is under construction with a completion date expected in late spring. Once that facility is complete, the district will turn its attention to the elementary campus for much needed improvements. This is an exciting time as we work to provide the type of facilities that our students and staff deserve.
