2019- 2020 Student Registration REMINDER

We ask that Parents/Guardians complete the **on-line registration system (Infinite Campus), online acknowledgement forms, and return the necessary forms ASAP to ensure accurate scheduling for the 2019-2020 school year.** All parents/guardians are required to complete the residency form and provide the necessary documentation to be considered enrolled for the 2019-2020 school year.

The registration fee per student is \$100 for the 2019-2020 school year. However, returning families completing the registration process **including completing the residency form and providing the necessary documents** before Friday, June 28, will be eligible for an early registration fee of \$50 per child. Parents/Guardians may also request a *School Fee Waiver Form* for the 2019-2020 School Year.

If you do not have internet access, you are welcome to come to the Hillside School Main Office between 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. to utilize our internet/computers. On the following days, we will be offering after-school times for parents/guardians to turn in their residency paperwork or access computers to complete the online registration.

ENROLL NOW- Early Childhood Program 2019-2020

We are excited to announce that Hillside School will offer pre-school for the 2019-2020 school year. Consistent with District 93's philosophy, our preschool serves the needs of children utilizing a developmentally - appropriate approach to instruction. The Pre-School program is OPEN to all families within the Hillside School District 93 boundaries.

This program is a multi-aged program that provides experiences for young children ages three through five, who have identified disabilities, young children needing additional support and/or for pre-school children within the Hillside School District 93 boundaries. All children have an opportunity to play and learn together in an accepting and engaging environment. It is not mandatory for preschoolers to be independent in their toileting skills, but it is encouraged.

The Early Childhood Program follows the District 93 Calendar and the sessions are Monday-Friday:

Morning Session: 8:45 -11:15 Afternoon Session 12:45 - 3:15
