Mr. Jenkins called the meeting to order and Rev. Dr. Tommy Kelly gave the invocation.

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to adopt the 2016-2017 budget on first reading. Mr. Murdaugh seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Superintendent's Report

Our Fund Balance as of today is \$700,000. Dr. McTeer stated that we have not received the State Department monies for this month.

The Board reconvened in Open Session.

Open Session

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to uphold the hearing officer's decision for Student #1. Mr. Murdaugh seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to expel Student #1 for the remainder of the 2015-2016 school year. Mr. Murdaugh seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to accept the recommendation of Mrs. Wilson and Mrs. Woodward to hire Romon Gray for the position of teacher. Mrs. Priester seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to give the chairman the authority to determine if there is a need to hire Jody Hadwin for the position of teacher. Mrs. Priester seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

Mrs. Murdaugh approved the recommendation to hire Kevin Palmer and Tonya Robinson as Special Ed Teachers and Kelly Wall as Speech Therapist. Mr. Murdaugh seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.
