Our primary responsibility is to preserve long held Native Hawaiian traditions and values. We respect, cherish and share all sources and records of the ancient traditions, na'ole a me na mele, traditional and historic sites of Hawai'i, endemic and indigenous flora and fauna of this land, and encourage 'olelo Hawai'i.

Criteria:

To qualify for scholarship funds from the KHCC, applicants must:

- Be of Hawaiian ancestry
- Be a resident of the Ko'olauloa moku (Kalai O I'o Point to Waimea Bay) for at least one year or a graduating student of Kahuku High & Intermediate School
- Be a classified student in a degree-seeking program or an apprentice in a cultural training program
- Be enrolled full/part-time in an accredited post-high institution
 - Hawaiian Studies
 - Hawaiian Language
- Satisfactorily meet academic or performance requirements
- Demonstrate the desire to perpetuate Hawaiian culture, values and language
- Minimum cumulative of 2.5 GPA from high school
